### **ARTICLE 4 : MEMBERSHIP, DISAFFILIATION, DE-RECOGNITION,** **SUSPENSION OF MEMBER UNIT.**

#### **4.1. Membership of the TFI shall be open to the following:-**

- a. State / U.T. Taekwondo Associations.
- b. Taekwondo Academy of India.
- c. Services Sports Control Board (without voting rights).
- d. School Games Federation of India (without voting rights).
- e. Association of Indian Universities (without voting rights).
- f. Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (without voting rights).
- g. Delhi Public School (without voting rights).
- h. Navodaya Vidyalaya (without voting rights).
- i. City Montessori School, (CMS) (without voting rights).

#### **4.2 Admittance into the TFI requires the approval of the Executive Council. The right of vote shall, however, accrue to the new members after ratification of the decision of the Executive Council (E.C.) by the General Body.**

#### **4.3 The TFI General Body on the recommendation of President or Secretary of TFI, either directly or through the TFI Executive Council, based on the discretion, is entitled to consider disaffiliation / de-recognition / suspension of the Member Unit on one or more of the under mentioned grounds after ensuring that a Show Cause Notice has been served and an explanation has been obtained and considered from the organization recommended for disaffiliation / de-recognition / suspension.**

- a. Non-observance of directives issued by the TFI from time to time.
- b. Not holding elections after the completion of the normal tenure for which the office bearers are elected. Any extension of the tenure of the office-bearers will be subject to obtaining prior written permission from the TFI.
- c. Not submitting annual audited statement of accounts, annual report and list of current office-bearers within the stipulated time period.
- d. Whatever the decision of the TFI General Body, it must be supported by two-third majority votes of the Members present and voting.
- e. If the TFI General Body takes a decision to disaffiliate a Member Unit, the President or the Secretary General of TFI will have the authority to constitute an ad-hoc body, preferably from amongst the Members of the TFI General Body to look after the work done by the disaffiliated Member Units till such time, that the President or the Secretary

**General of TFI arranges for fresh elections to be held in the concerned Member Unit which would then start functioning in the normal manner. However, the students of Taekwondo shall not be affected by such a change and will be deemed to be under the new Association.**

- f. If State / U.T. Taekwondo Association or Member Units deliberately/ Intentionally violate the Rules & Regulation/Constitution of TFI, that Member Unit shall be debarred from all activities under TFI.**
- 4.4. Elected / Nominated representative of the State level units and Elected / Nominated Office Bearers of the Executive Council shall be members for the tenure (normally four years at a time). There shall be life members and Patrons also when they are duly nominated by the Executive Council or/and General Body.**
- 4.5. Membership of the Office Bearers shall cease consequent to their death, turning mad, and conviction by Court of Law in criminal case, insolvency or any misconduct for which he/she might be dismissed by the competent authority of TFI.**
- 4.6. Membership of State Association may be terminated by the Executive Council, if it had obtained affiliation with TFI by fraudulent means or by policy incorrect information to the Federation. Similar action shall be taken, if its Office Bearers, severally and its General Body and Executive Council had failed to take appropriate action advised by the Federation.**
- 4.7. None of the Office Bearers can hold office if he/she is an office Bearer in any National Body concerning Sports, except Indian Olympic Association (IOA), Sports Authority of India (SAI) etc.**
- 4.8. Admittance into the TFI required the approval of the Executive Council. The right of vote shall, however accrue to the new member after notification of the decision of the Executive Council ( E.C. ) by the General Body (G.B.). The Affiliated State's Taekwondo Association shall not have more than 5 (five ) persons in their Executive Body , who have not been student of Taekwondo . The TFI shall appoint a Technical Director in each state, preferably from the State itself , wherever possible who will be responsible for all technical matters including recommendation of State Taekwondo Team for Zonal and National Championship. " The Technical Director should ensure that the colour Belt Examination are being Conducted timely and the marks sheets,I. Card are being send in time The Technical Director will be ex-officio member with voting right of the Executive Body of the concern State [UT/Organisational Association and shall be directly responsible to the Technical Chairman.**
- 4.9. The TFI shall admit normally only one Taekwondo Association / Organization from a State or a Union Territory. "The TFI may admit Department of Sports or a Sports Organization, having more than five games." It may however , admit more than one Association / Organization, if it deems fit in view of peculiar circumstances of the State / Union Territory.**

- 4.10. If more than one Organisation claim to represent a State / Union Territory. The dispute shall be referred to the Executive Council. It may if deemed necessary, seek information and advice of the Indian Olympic Association, State Olympic Committee or and State Departments of Sports for taking a final decision.**
- 4.11. All State Taekwondo Association affiliated to the Federation shall commit themselves to appeal only to the President of the TFI and thereafter finally to the President-IOA, in the event of the any differences, which may arise with regards to the functioning of any State Association or the Federation within its laid down statues and regulations. States Taekwondo Association shall not be allowed to appeal to any other Jurisdiction.**
- 4.12. If any State Taekwondo Association does not take recourse to normally available avenues i.e. contacting and meeting with TFI Secretariat, appeal to the President TFI and thereafter appeal to IOA, to redress its grievances, and moves directly to a Court of Law, to obtain stay order for any National Level Championship, this act will be considered as a case of gross misconduct and following penalty will be imposed :**
- a. Expulsion of President and Secretary of the concerned State Association and election of new Office Bearers within a period of 3 months from the date of this Act.**
  - c. De-affiliation of the State Taekwondo Association, if it fails to comply with the directives of expulsion and re-election as indicated above.**
- 4.13. If a State Taekwondo Association is de-affiliated , the Federation shall be empowered to grant affiliation to any other Association in that State. The de-affiliated Association shall have no claim thereafter to represent the Sport of Taekwondo in that State. however, the students of Taekwondo shall not be effected by such change and will be deemed to be under the new Association.**
- 4.14. A member State/UT/Organisational Taekwondo Association or any of its members shall neither be affiliated to any other National Taekwondo Organizational not recognised by the WTF /TFI, nor participate in any Taekwondo Events organised by such an Organisation.**
